

We have NEW Referee Game Reports! AGAIN!!!

NWOYSL is trying something new this season. We have issued new game reports. We hope they will be easier for you, and the office staff, and the referees.

Everyone will receive **10 GREEN sheets double sided, perforated game reports** in your packets. We listened to feedback from our last reports, and many of you still wanted a part of the report with the scores. So we have a perforated section that the referee will hand back to you after the game. Also we have added coaches' initials next to the score.

You will need to fill out the following information on the Referee Reports:

On the Front:

1. Date
2. Time
3. Field #
4. Site
5. Gender of Division
6. Age Group
7. Game Number
8. Home Team
9. Away Team
10. List Home or Away Team!
11. List any Guest Players (remember to review our rules for guest players)
12. Indicate if Club Coach and Name (if they are coaching this game)

Also on the front: (The Perforated Section) the next part is what the referee will hand back to you after the game.

- Date
- Time
- Field #
- Site
- Gender of Division
- Age Group
- Game Number
- Home Team
- Away Team

On the back of the form: the referee will use that side to record any yellow and or red cards issued during that match. Space will be provided for addition comments from the referee to our office.

Each team, **HOME and AWAY**, will then attach a Roster to the game report. The game reports will be handed over to the referees. The Home Team will still provide a postage paid envelope to the referee. You will have enough white envelopes in your packet for every home game.

Each Club Contact will receive a PDF file of your roster. Each team will need to print out one roster per game. Players do not need to sign this roster but jersey numbers are a must. If a Referee Report is mailed in without a Roster Print out, you will face disciplinary actions and fines per the NWOYSL Executive Board.

If you add a player, drop a player or change your roster in anyway during the season - we will send out a new PDF file. You then will have to print out new rosters and attach to your game reports.
