MISCONDUCTS

Cautionary Offenses (Yellow Card)

1. Unsporting behavior.
2. Shows dissent by words or actions.
3. Persistently infringes on the laws of the game.
4. Delays the restart of the game.
5. Fails to respect the required distance when play is restarted with a corner kick or free kick.
6. Enters or reenters the field of play without the referee's permission.
7. Deliberately leaves the field of play without the referee's permission.

Sent off Offenses (Red Card)

- A. Guilty of serious foul play.
- B. Guilty of violent conduct.
- C. Spits at an opponent or any other person.
- D. Denies an opponent a goal or an obvious goal scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball.
- E. Denies an obvious goal scoring opportunity to an opponent moving toward the player's goal by an offense punishable by a free kick or a penalty kick.
- F. Uses offensive, insulting or abusive language.
- G. Receives a second caution in the same match.

Each team, home and away are responsible for Total \$ per Game, as mentioned above.

A Three-man referee system is mandatory for all U11 thru U19 games. A one-man referee system is mandatory for all U9 and U10 games. (Only certified referees are to be paid, per agreement with the Northwest Ohio Soccer Officials Association.) If only one or two referees are present, they are to receive the appropriate fee only. They may not be paid for two positions or all the pay for being the only one present. If a game is called before half-time due to inclement weather, the score will not stand and all referees monies must be returned to the appropriate teams.

If no referee is present at game time, each team shall referee one-half of the game, unless they can find a replacement certified referee, coach or other spectator.

REFEREE DUTIES:

1. Arrive early to the scheduled match in proper attire. (For description of correct attire, refer to the Northwest Ohio Soccer Officials Association – www.NWOSOA.org).
2. Check both teams in prior to the start of the game.
 - a. Ask opposing team if they would like to be present at check in (optional).
 - b. Verify player pass to player and to NWOYSL official team roster. Mark present or absent on the Game Report.
 - c. Player passes must all state NWOYSL and show current season year.
 - d. Player passes have stickers showing age group on the picture side. Any different colors should be noted.
 - e. All guest players must be listed on the Game Report and must have a current NWOYSL player pass.
 - f. Please inform opposing coach prior to the game of any discrepancies, and note it on the white copy of Game Reports.
 - g. Any player arriving after the start of the game must be verified by the center referee or an assistant referee before he/she will be permitted to play. Opposing coach should also be told of players arriving late.
3. Games shall play by the NWOYSL Rules and Regulations.
4. Only players and coaches listed on the front of the Game Report are permitted on the side line.
5. Each coach is responsible for reporting the score of their game, win or loss. This is done by logging onto the NWOYSL website, www.nwoysl.org, and following the reporting match scores link. This must be done within 48 hours of completion of the match.
